I am to inform you to reconstitute the Anti-Ragging Committee as per the Medical Council of India Notification “No. MCI-341(1)/2009-Med./25453, In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 33 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956) the Medical Council of India.

Every institution should have an Anti-Ragging Committee and an Anti -Ragging Squad.
The Anti-Ragging Committee shall be constituted as mandated and mentioned below:

9	Representative of Non-Teaching Staff

Every Institutions Anti – Ragging Committee should monitor the Ragging activities in the their institutions.

- ii, Conclusion of the investigations,

- iv) Report should be on Letter Head of the institution or with the stamp of the Head of the Institution in PDF, Doc or JPED format along with all supported documents
- v) Kindly mention your Regulatory Authority of your reputed institution/University (i.e. UGC, MCI, NAAC, MHRD, AICTE etc) and if we are failed to contact you, call us on our helpline number, so that we can brief the case to you.
- vi. Details of punishment for the culprits, if any etc.
- vii Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- viii Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- ix Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences
- x Extortion
- xi Physical or psychological humiliation

Note: Enquiry / Investigation / Disciplinary Committee report etc., are not acceptable, as per UGC regulations only, report of the Anti ragging Committee is acceptable.

All the affiliated institutions are requested to **constitute or reconstitute** the Anti-Ragging Committee as given in the norms , if **failure to** constitute of Anti-Ragging Committee it will attract a fine of up to INR 1 lakh/INR 5,000/- per day till such committee is formed.

Any report from any other such enquiry committee will not be valid.

In view of the above, all the Deans/Principals of the institutions with affiliated to this University are instructed and to take immediate action in this regard
