A total of 37 students were placed in various reputed companies during this academic year. Two students are opting for higher studies.

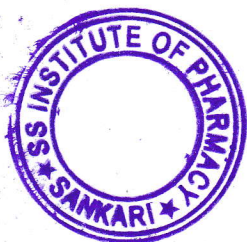
MOUs were signed with 5 renowned organization for this academic year, various academic related and placement oriented training program were conducted in association with these organizations.

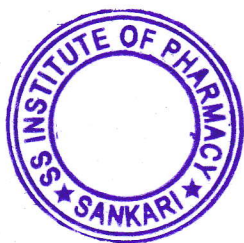
