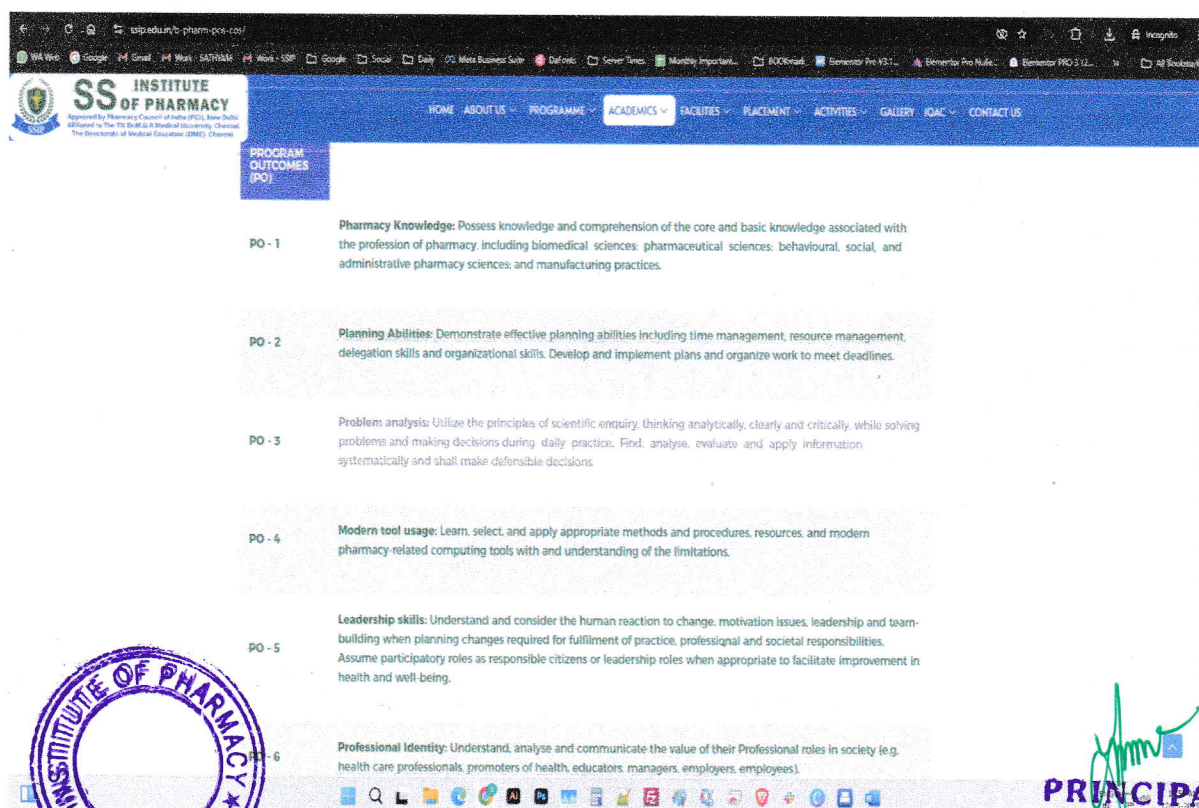
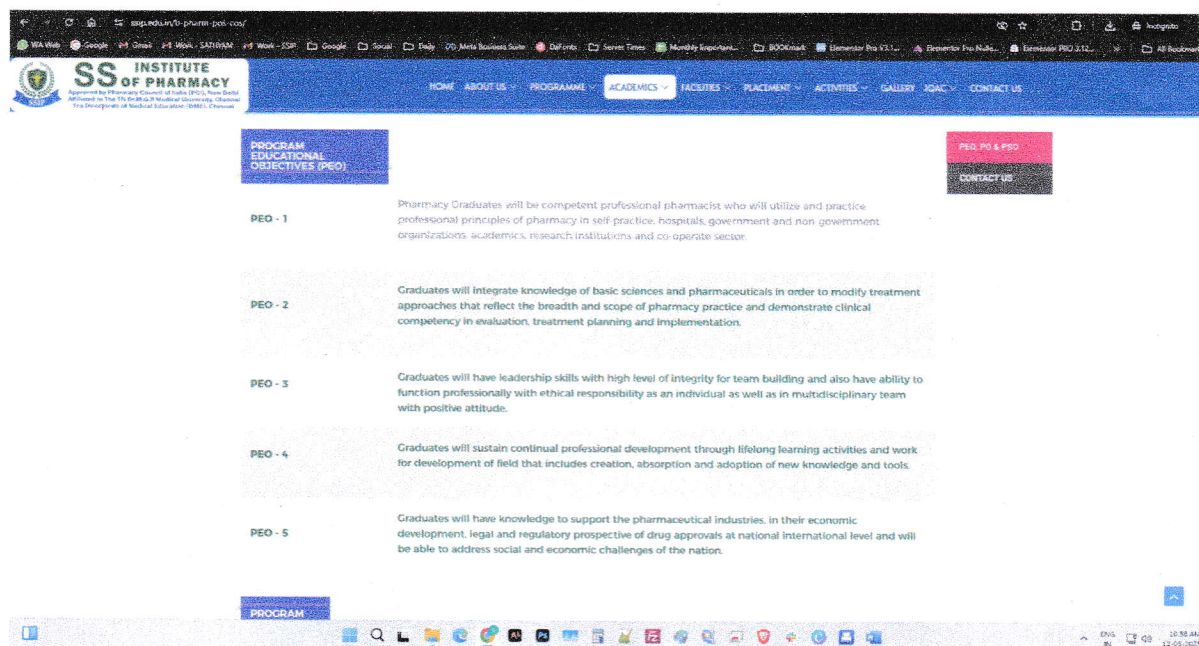

I. PROGRAM EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES (PEOs)

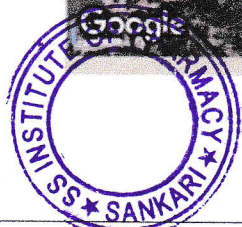
